

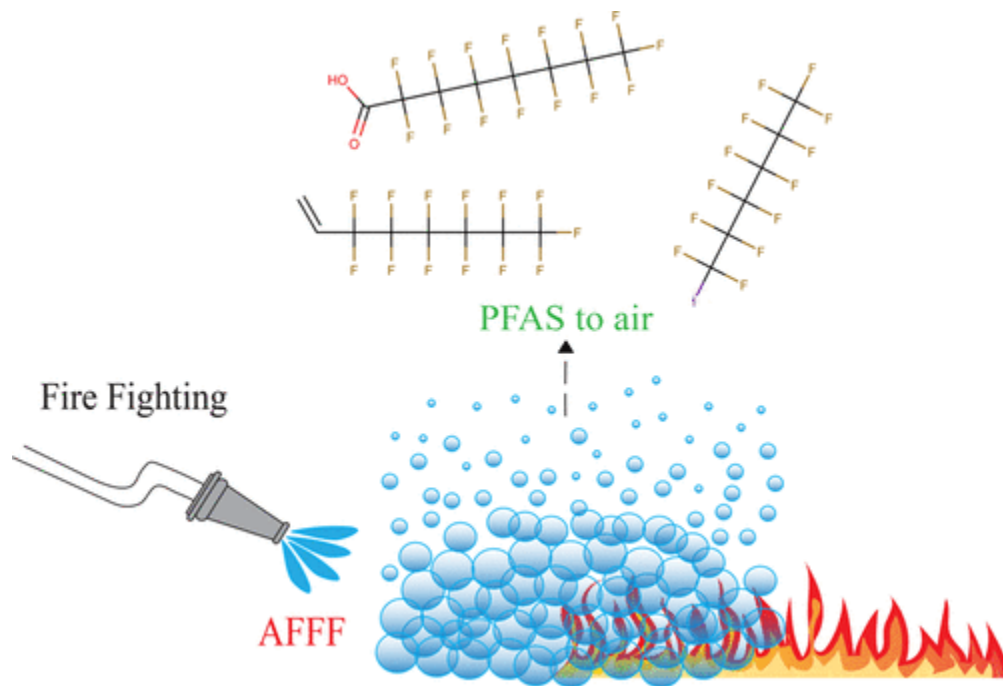

Incident Command (IC) – PFAS

Incident Command is on the scene to ensure PFAS safety.

When water changes to steam, its volume increases.

Water boils at 212° F and expands in volume by a factor of 1700 times. AFFF at the boiling point will do the same.



PFAS creates different variables: vapor.
