The AFFF debacle is a result of regulatory failure and corporate deception.

Where is the fire service leadership on PFAS!?

- The US Fire Administration (USFA) was previously a direct cabinet position of the Executive Branch. It became a non-cabinet position in 2003 when they were folded into Homeland Security. Homeland Security's budget is \$90 billion. USFA's budget is \$370 million for SAFER grants and \$60.4 million for the Administration.
- Are grants really the best distribution system for funds?
- EPA does not approve firefighting foams. They do approve foams for "spills" or "spill control agent."
- Misrepresentation and lies throughout from corporations and the USEPA. EPA became aware of the PFAS fire issues in the 1990s. Companies knew decades before that. Why does it take 28 years to formulate regs? There are no regulations requiring AFFF use.
